What is Shavuot?

The holiday of Shavuot is a two-day holiday, beginning at sundown on June 8th and lasting until nightfall on June 10th. The word ‘Shavuot’ means ‘weeks’ as it celebrates the completion of the seven-week Omer, which is the counting period between Passover and Shavuot. The Torah was given by G-d to the Jewish people on Mount Sinai on Shavuot more than 3300 years ago. Every year on the holiday of Shavuot, we renew our acceptance of G-d’s gift, and G-d regifts the Torah. It is customary to eat dairy foods on the holiday.

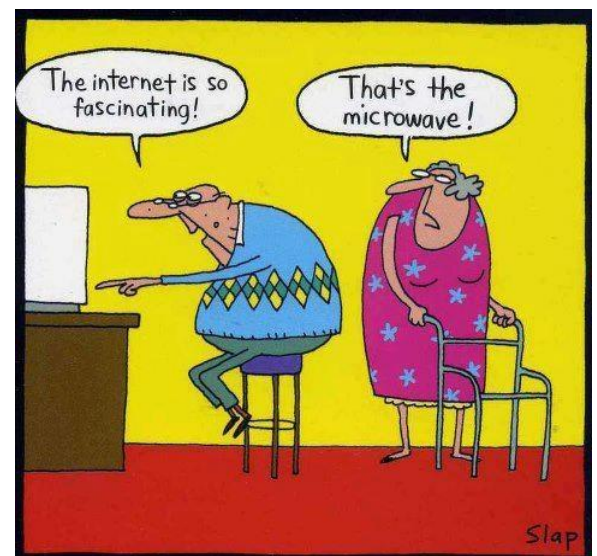
