A Period of Mourning: July 21 – August 11

The 17th of Tammuz (July 21st) is observed as a day of fasting. On this date, in the year 68, the walls of Jerusalem were breached by the Roman years of siege. The Jewish forces continued to defend the Temple for another 19 days, until it too fell on the 7th of Av. The Biet HaMikdash, the Holy Temple, was torched late on Av 9. The entire period, totaling 21 days, is observed not by scheduling any weddings, as well as avoiding festive music and dancing. This year, because the fast days fall on Shabbat, the observances are postponed until Sunday.
